

**Chautauqua Lake Twin Tier Chapter, ACBS Inc.  
Meeting Number 25**

**March 14, 2009**

**See-Zurh House, Bemus Point NY**

The meeting was called to order at noon by President Reynolds. He outlined the meeting agenda: Review of the boat show registration package; The upcoming workshop sponsored by the North Coast Ohio Chapter, ACBS; and the review of the boat show Task List.

1. Registration Package: One suggestion and one comment were made. The suggestion was to add mention of Hotel Lenhart in the registration letter. Tony Hopfinger agreed to see how this could be accomplished while keeping the letter to one page.

A comment was made regarding the disclaimer wording on the registration form. After discussion, it was agreed to accept the words as written on the registration form. Tony Hopfinger agreed to create a separate entry entitled "Thoughts & New Ideas" on the Task List for future consideration and add this review as an item.

2. Workshop: The President advised the members that the North Coast Ohio chapter is sponsoring a workshop and encouraged members to consider attending. Some of the members indicated they would be attending. (Note: information re the workshop is available on our Club Web site.)

Also discussed was the idea of club members attending other club boat shows. A suggestion was made for those attending to wear/show our club logo. It was mentioned that those of our club that attended Niagara boat show last year wore shirt with our club logo and that it make a statement. A number of members indicated intent to attend other shows. T. Hopfinger agreed to create a list of who might be attending other club boat shows so the club can attempt to attend as many shows as possible by various members.

3. Task List Review: The President turned the meeting over to T. Hopfinger to address the items on the Task List. An emphasis was made to fill in names where needed on the List. As a result T. Hopfinger will reissue the list within the next 10 days reflecting the meeting discussions.

Some of the highlights are:

1. Andy Robinson, show chairman, sealed the discussion of T. Hopfinger being co-chairman.
2. Adding under the heading of New Ideas (besides reviewing the disclaimer) to consider the Hotel Lenhart as the host hotel.
3. Create a pamphlet advertising the boat show.
4. Consider another award vs. the paddle, i.e., "transom" type award as displayed by Mark O'Donnell.

5. Charge vendors a \$35.00 fee for an on-land display area of 10x20 pending OK from the village.

4. Open Discussion: Mark O'Donnell offered a number of thoughts and ideas for consideration such as having another award in lieu of the paddle or for a "showing". The example given was that of a boat transom wood plaque. This would allow the registrant to acquire the award as he/she registers (vs. during the banquet). Mark also presented various poster concepts to be used in connection with the boat show and youth items for a youth activity event for the show for future consideration. T. Hopfinger stated that these items will be added to the Task List.

Meeting adjourned at 2:40pm.
